 - d. Tie downs for sea trains. (Waiting for the word from the County of Kern and 5 Dogs range)
 - e. Extend the back of the cover on the firing line at an angle. (Turned down by 5 Dogs range in the past, Blocks traffic)
 - f. More rifle racks (What is the cost?)
 - g. Push brooms (What is the cost?)
 - h. Fill cinder blocks around score shed in with concrete to keep out squirrels. (What is the cost?)
 - i. More tables to use for classes and barbeques. (The Shotgun program has included more tables in their program grant.)
 - j. Replace/ repair floor in cook shed. (What is the cost?)
 - k. Close the openings under job box and under sea trains. (What is the cost?)
 - l. Replace the old storage shed at far end of pit. (Leave it alone at this time.)
 - m. Possible holes that need to be repaired in good target shed. (What is the cost and what needs to be repaired?)

n. Need a better gong for Family Fun Day. (What is the cost?)(Possible donation from one of the club members.)

George Stilwill said that he will apply for the grant, but he will need someone to come up with a cost break down for each improvement.
