MINUTES FROM MEETING OF

JANUARY 26,2019

Executive Committee Business Meeting There was no executive committee business. No meeting was held.

General Business Meeting

The General meeting of Kern Shooting Sports was called to order by President Jay Busby at 9:00 am.

Minutes from Deember 2018 were presented for errors. Daryl Amble moved to accept minutes as written. Tom Victor seconded the motion. Motion passed.

PRESIDENTS REPORT: JAY BUSBY

- 1) 5 Dogs range will be increasing its Range Fees. Yearly Fees will increase from \$175.00 to \$185.00 and the daily fee will increase from \$10.00 to \$12.00.
- 2) 5 Dogs Range will need our range area for a long week end at some time, yet to be determined, in the future. When they find out the date they will let us know because we will have to work around their schedule and perhaps even cancel events we have schedules. Powers Security is doing the negotiations for this event and George will send out an e-mail when we have the details.
- 3) The floor of the cookshack needs to be replaced.

- 4) Vince Fong's office will get back to Jay regarding our dispersing ammunition and firearms to our students considering all the new laws that have or may have passed.
- 5) KSS members will be required to sign in and pay at the 5 Dogs office unless they are participating in a KSS function such as NRA sponsored events or high power matches.
- 6) Steel plate must be at least 15 yards away and jacketed ammunition will be allowed at that range.
- 7) Signs are posted at the KSS range for all Rules and Regulations.
- 8) The NRA Range Grant request was denied this year due to a lack of NRA funds.
- 9) The KSS accomplishments this year include the following:
 - a. TNT safes has changed the locks on 4 of our 5 gun safes
 - b. Shotgun range shade was put up and donated by 5 Dogs
 - c. Foam has been in the legs of our wooden benches to keep the spiders out.
 - d. There are barrels for empty brass. We are collecting them for money.
 - e. Bob Machi and Bill Bright have removed the scrap metal
 - f. AR15's owned by the club have been modified to make them legal
 - g. Pavers for the second canopy have been laid behind the score shed
 - h. The club now has cables and clamps to secure the Seatrains
- 10) Job Box Contents are:
 - a. Carpets
 - b. Cardboard backers
 - c. Ear and Eye protection
 - d. Sand Bags
 - e. Spotting Scope
 - f. Stapler and Staples
 - g. Target clips

- h. Target base
 - i. Spikes and a hammer
- 11) UPDATE ON FIREARMS BILLS
- a. SB 1100 Firearms Transfers. This will become effective on July 1, 2019. There will be a fee for the transfer.
 - b. Ammunition sales will require a background check. So far no limits on the amount and the club is okay with having ammunition for the NRA sponsored classes and events as long as 5 Dogs has an active license to receive and sell the ammunition. There will probably be a fee to pay for the background check.
 - c. All members should consider a membership to CRPA (California Rifle and Pistol Association) if they want access to updated information on these topics.
 - d. Question from the audience about Flash Suppressors. At this time Flash suppressors are not legal. However, you can legally have a muzzle break.
 - e. When transporting firearms, without a concealed weapons permit, the law requires that you have made your firearm and its ammunition separate, secure and un-accessible.

VICE PRESIDENTS REPORT: DAVE MARTIN

- 1) Dave reported that there are now 16 new students and 16 returning students signed up for the Shotgun Program.
- 2) 5 Dogs range has come up with a new Liability Sheet that all of our programs and events need to have for sign ins.
- 3) The Boy Scouts used one of our shotguns at their last event at 5 Dogs. It was returned in good condition.
- 4) FFA used one of our portable clay throwers for their program.
- 5) Next years Shotgun Grant Request is in process at the NRA.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Lela Martin

- 1) The monthly meetings have been scheduled at Lorene's for the 3rd Tuesday of each month
- 2) The High Power match request has been sent to the NRA for approval
- 3) A gentleman (name Sanchez) texted to Lela and wanted to join the shotgun class with his family. He was not declined since we are unsure of the laws and how we should handle this. He was actually unable to attend because he had a work conflict, but we may have him and his family next year.
